Chou Associates Management Inc. ("the Manager") manages the overall business of the Fund, including the selection of the securities in the Fund's portfolio and promoting sales of the Fund's units. For the purposes of this document, the terms Chou Associates Management Inc. and "the Manager" are interchangeable. Full contact information for the Manager is located at the end of this report.

Management Discussion of Fund Performance

Investment Objective and Strategies

Chou Asia Fund's (the "Fund") objective is to provide long-term growth of capital by investing primarily in the securities markets of Asia considered by Chou Associates Management Inc. (the "Manager") to be undervalued. The Fund may also invest in securities other than equities and in businesses located in Asia. The Fund's investments may also include common and preferred shares, convertible debentures, warrants, government and corporate bonds and short-term indebtedness.

The Fund's investment strategy follows a strong discipline with regard to the prices paid to acquire portfolio investments. The level of investments in a particular entity's securities is generally commensurate with the current price of the company's securities in relation to the Manager's assessment of such entity's intrinsic value as determined by various factors. This approach is designed to provide an extra margin of safety, which in turn, serves to reduce the Fund's overall portfolio risk.

Risk

The risks of investing in the Fund are disclosed in the Fund's most recently filed Simplified Prospectus which can be found on the Fund's website at www.sedar.com.

During the year ended December 31, 2016, there were no material changes that affected the Fund's overall level of risk.

Results of Operations

For the year ended December 31, 2016, the Fund increased by 2.1% for Series A units and 2.7% for Series F units after fees and expenses, while the MSCI AC Asia Pacific Total Return Index increased by 2.5% in Canadian dollars. In U.S. dollars, the Fund was up 5.2% for Series A units and 5.8% for Series F units, while the MSCI AC Asia Pacific Total Return Index returned 5.4%.

The Asian equity markets grew modestly in 2016, with varying results by region. Structural and debt-related issues continued to linger in China as the Chinese authorities dealt with growing debt, changing demographics and a challenging export environment. China's Shanghai Composite declined 12.3% during the year, its largest drop since 2011 when the index lost 21.7%. China's monetary and fiscal policies were expansionary with high state-led investments and a gradually weakening yuan. Continued depreciation of the Chinese yuan has led to intensified capital outflows. Also present are the risks of a potential trade war with U.S. President Donald Trump's administration.

Low economic growth and inflation have persisted in Japan despite years of large-scale quantitative easing. Japan's Nikkei narrowly increased 0.4% in 2016. The government, led by Prime Minister Shinzo Abe, announced a new fiscal stimulus package of ¥28 trillion (US\$276 billion) in July 2016, promising further spending on transportation and disaster zone infrastructure projects, as well as subsidies for child- and eldercare workers. The Bank of Japan stated its intention to continue buying long-term government bonds at 80 trillion yen (US\$781 billion) annually and has recommitted to its elusive pursuit of the 2% inflation rate.

Top gainers during 2016 were the equity holdings of AJIS Company Limited, POSCO Sponsored ADR and BYD Company Limited.

Most of the declines came from the equity securities of Pyne Gould Corporation. The renminbi had depreciated against the Canadian currency during the period, which also negatively impacted the Fund.

The Fund sold all shares in Glacier Media Inc.

In 2016, the Fund received \$44,996 in income from its securities lending program.

The Fund did not enter into any foreign currency contracts during the period ended December 31, 2016.

The Fund's net redemptions for the year ended December 31, 2016 were approximately \$5,300,569 for Series A units and the Fund's Series F net purchases were approximately \$34,338. The Fund's average month-end cash position for the year was 69.0% of the Fund's net assets.

Recent Developments

There have been no recent market developments of particular note, aside from the normal fluctuations of the markets that are expected to have an undue influence on the portfolio of the Fund when compared to its benchmark.

Related Party Transactions

The Manager manages the overall business of the Fund, including selection of the securities in the Fund's portfolio, and promoting the sale of the Fund's units.

The Manager is also the trustee of the Fund. Investors receive units of a trust when they invest in the Fund. The Manager, as trustee, holds actual title to the property in the Fund, the cash and portfolio securities, on behalf of the Fund's investors.

The Manager, its officers and directors invest in units of the Fund from time to time in the normal course of business. All transactions with the Manager are measured at the exchange amounts.

During the year ended December 31, 2016, there were no transactions with related parties except in the capacities and instances set out above.

⁽⁵⁾ Management expense ratio ("MER") is based on total expenses (excluding commissions and other portfolio transaction costs) for the stated period and is expressed as an annualized percentage of weekly average net asset value during the period. The Manager may, at its discretion, waive or absorb certain operating expenses. MER includes the waiver or absorption by the Manager of certain operating expenses, while the MER before absorption shows the MER prior to operating expenses being waived or absorbed by the Manager.

⁽⁶⁾ The trading expense ratio represents total commissions and other portfolio transaction costs expressed as an annualized percentage of weekly average net asset value during the period.

⁽⁷⁾ The Fund's portfolio turnover rate indicates how actively the Fund's portfolio adviser manages its portfolio investments. A portfolio turnover rate of 100% is equivalent to the Fund buying and selling all of the securities in its portfolio once in the course of the year. The higher a fund's portfolio turnover rate in a year, the greater the trading costs payable by the fund in the year, and the greater the chance of an investor receiving taxable capital gains in the year. There is not necessarily a relationship between a high turnover rate and the performance of a fund.

⁽⁸⁾ Information from 2013 and thereafter is in accordance with IFRS. Information for years prior to 2013 is reported under Canadian GAAP.

Management Fees

The Manager manages the Fund. The Manager is entitled to an investment management fee calculated daily as a percentage of the market value of the net assets equal to 1.5% per annum for Series A units and 1.0% per annum for Series F units, payable monthly. The Manager pays 50 basis points per year trailer fees to dealers out of management fees for Series A units. There is no trailer fee paid out for Series F units.

Past Performance


General


Year-by-Year Returns

Annual Compound Returns

Also shown for the same periods are the respective historical annual compound total returns or changes of the MSCI Asia Pacific Index (the "Index"). The Index is based on the market capitalizations of approximately 900 leading companies publicly traded in the three developed market countries and eight emerging market countries in Asia. The benchmark Index is calculated without the deduction of management fees and fund expenses, whereas the performance of the Fund is calculated after deducting such fees and expenses.
