Chou Associates Management Inc. ("the Manager") manages the overall business of the Fund, including the selection of the securities in the Fund's portfolio and promoting sales of the Fund's units. For the purposes of this document, the terms Chou Associates Management Inc. and "the Manager" are interchangeable. Full contact information for the Manager is located at the end of this report.

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Management Discussion of Fund Performance

Investment Objective and Strategies

Chou Asia Fund's (the "Fund") objective is to provide long-term growth of capital by investing primarily in the securities markets of Asia considered by Chou Associates Management Inc. (the "Manager") to be undervalued. The Fund may also invest in securities other than equities and in businesses located in Asia. The Fund's investments may also include common and preferred shares, convertible debentures, warrants, government and corporate bonds and short-term indebtedness.

The Fund's investment strategy follows a strong discipline with regard to the prices paid to acquire portfolio investments. The level of investments in a particular entity's securities is generally commensurate with the current price of the company's securities in relation to the Manager's assessment of such entity's intrinsic value as determined by various factors. This approach is designed to provide an extra margin of safety, which in turn, serves to reduce the Fund's overall portfolio risk.

Risk

The risks of investing in the Fund are disclosed in the Fund's most recently filed Simplified Prospectus which can be found on the Fund's website at www.choufunds.com and SEDAR at www.sedar.com.

During the year ended December 31, 2017, there were no material changes that affected the Fund's overall level of risk.

Market Review

The Asian equity markets rebounded with a strong run in 2017, spurred on by the broader "Trump bump" rally seen in global stock markets. In China, stocks had strong gains, driven by continued positive news for the world's second-largest economy, and a stabilizing Chinese yuan. Aggressive measures to curb excess capacity in sectors such as steel, coal and aluminium fuelled a commodity price rally in the industrial sector. State-owned enterprises in energy and mining benefited greatly. Ongoing restrictions on the property market and a tightening on capital outflows also enabled liquidity to divert into equities.

Korean stocks saw positive performance after an election victory for new President Moon Jae-In – who is looking to reinvigorate the economy and implement meaningful corporate governance reforms.

Despite weakening in the first half of the year, the Japanese market trended upwards in the final four months of 2017, as Prime Minister Shinzo Abe was victorious in a snap election in October. This has been interpreted to mean a likely a continuation of loose monetary policy as inflation continued to lag expectations.

Results of Operations

For the year ended December 31, 2017, the Fund increased by 21.1% for Series A units and 21.8% for Series F units after fees and expenses, while the MSCI AC Asia Pacific Total Return Index increased by 23.2% in Canadian dollars. In U.S. dollars, the Fund was up 29.4% for Series A units and 30.1% for Series F units, while the MSCI AC Asia Pacific Total Return Index returned 32.3%.

Top gainers in 2017 were the equity holdings of POSCO Sponsored ADR, BYD Company Limited, BYD Electronic Company, China Yuchai International, and Pyne Gould Corporation.

The renminbi had appreciated against the Canadian currency during the year, which also positively impacted the Fund.

The Fund reduced holdings of BYD Electronic Company and increased holdings of Pyne Gould Corporation in 2017.

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The Fund received \$105,669 in income from its securities lending program in 2017.

The Fund did not enter into any foreign currency contracts during the period ended December 31, 2017.

The Fund's net redemptions for the period ended December 31, 2017 were approximately \$12,295,181 for Series A units and approximately \$135,488 for Series F units. The Fund's average month-end cash position for the period was 54.3% of the Fund's net assets.

Recent Developments

There have been no recent market developments of particular note, aside from the normal fluctuations of the markets that are expected to have an undue influence on the portfolio of the Fund when compared to its benchmark.

Related Party Transactions

The Manager manages the overall business of the Fund, including selection of the securities in the Fund's portfolio, and promoting the sale of the Fund's units.

The Manager is also the trustee of the Fund. Investors receive units of a trust when they invest in the Fund. The Manager, as trustee, holds actual title to the property in the Fund, the cash and portfolio securities, on behalf of the Fund's investors.

The Manager, its officers and directors invest in units of the Fund from time to time in the normal course of business. All transactions with the Manager are carried out at the Fund's net asset value as at the transaction date. As of December 31, 2017, the Manager does not hold any units of the Fund.

During the year, there were no transactions with related parties except in the capacities and instances set out above.

(1) This information is derived from the Fund's audited annual and unaudited semi-annual financial statements. For financial reporting purposes, prior to January 1, 2013, under Canadian GAAP, the net assets per security presented in the financial statements differ from the net asset value calculated for fund pricing purposes.

(2) Net assets and distributions are based on the actual number of redeemable units outstanding at the relevant time. The increase/decrease from operations is based on the weighted average number of redeemable units outstanding over the financial period.

(3) Distributions were reinvested in additional units of the Fund or paid in cash upon request.

(4) This information is provided as at year end shown and is rounded to the nearest thousand.

(5) Management expense ratio ("MER") is based on total expenses (excluding commissions and other portfolio transaction costs) for the stated period and is expressed as an annualized percentage of weekly average net asset value during the period. The Manager may, at its discretion, waive or absorb certain operating expenses. MER includes the waiver or absorption by the Manager of certain operating expenses, while the MER before absorption shows the MER prior to operating expenses being waived or absorbed by the Manager.

(6) The trading expense ratio represents total commissions and other portfolio transaction costs expressed as an annualized percentage of weekly average net asset value during the year.

(7) The Fund's portfolio turnover rate indicates how actively the Fund's portfolio adviser manages its portfolio investments. A portfolio turnover rate of 100% is equivalent to the Fund buying and selling all of the securities in its portfolio once in the course of the year. The higher a fund's portfolio turnover rate in a year, the greater the trading costs payable by the fund in the year, and the greater the chance of an investor receiving taxable capital gains in the year. There is not necessarily a relationship between a high turnover rate and the performance of a fund.

(8) Information from 2013 and thereafter is in accordance with IFRS. Information for years prior to 2013 is reported under Canadian GAAP.

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Management Fees

The Manager manages the Fund. The Manager is entitled to an investment management fee calculated daily as a percentage of the market value of the net assets equal to 1.5% per annum for Series A units and 1.0% per annum for Series F units, payable monthly. The Manager pays 50 basis points per year trailer fees to dealers out of management fees for Series A units. There is no trailer fee paid out for Series F units.

Past Performance

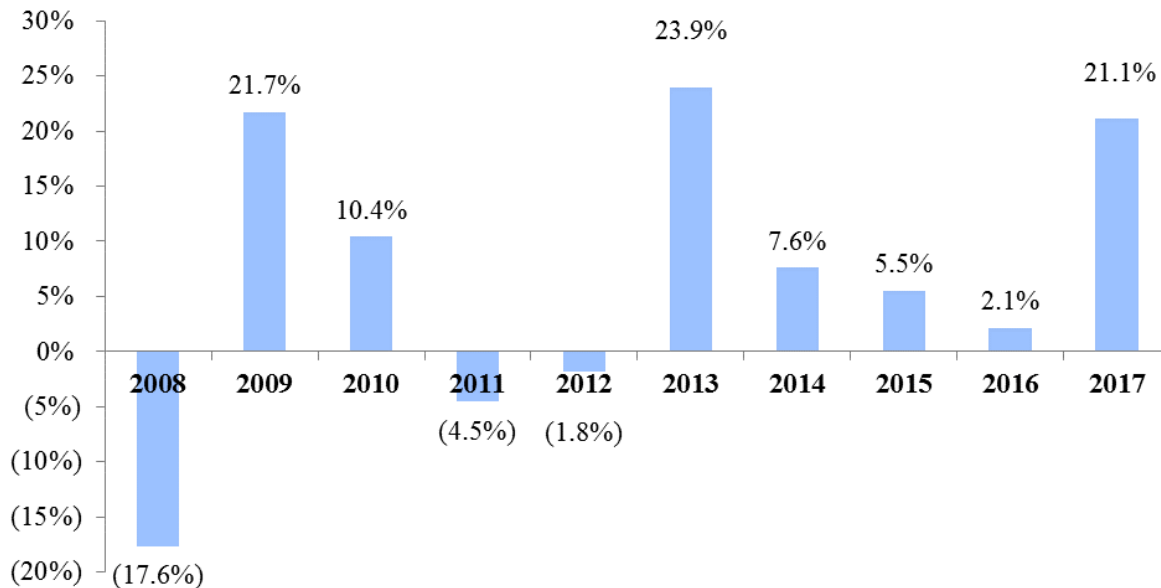
General

Year-by-Year Returns

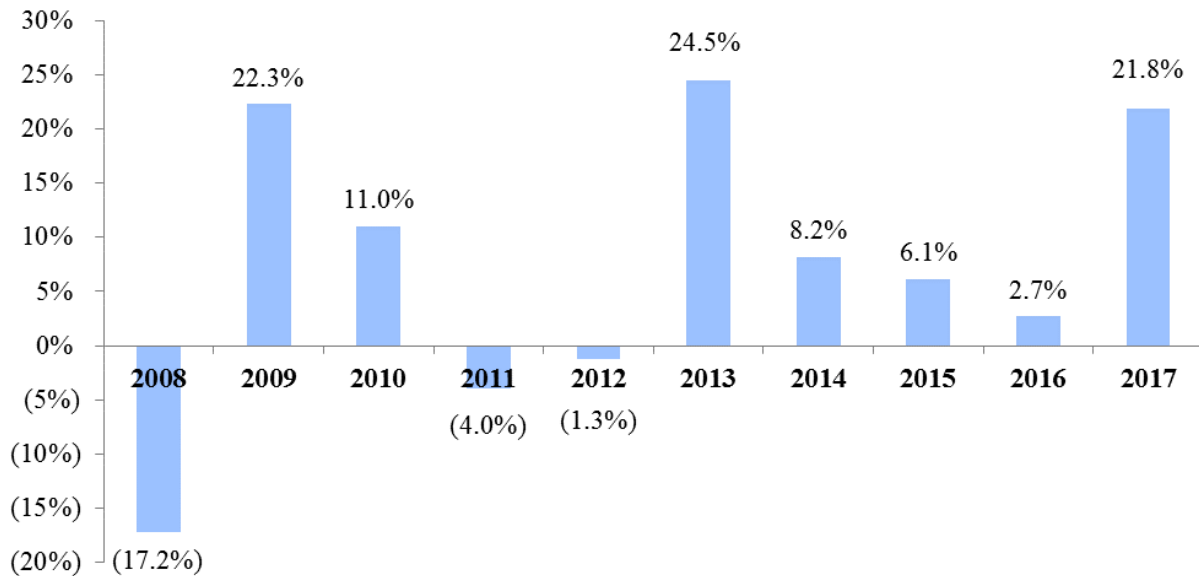

Annual Compound Returns

The following tables⁽¹⁾ show the annual compound total return for each of the Series A and Series F units of the Fund. The tables outline the Fund's past performance since inception and for the one-, three-, five- and ten-year periods ended on December 31, 2017. Also shown for the same periods are the respective historical annual compound total returns of the MSCI Asia Pacific Index (the "Index"). The Index is based on the market capitalizations of approximately 900 leading companies publicly traded in the three developed market countries and eight emerging market countries in Asia. The benchmark Index is calculated without the deduction of management fees and fund expenses, whereas the performance of the Fund is calculated after deducting such fees and expenses.
